PURPOSE AND GOALS

The Community Outreach Committee will consist of two Council members, community groups and individuals that work together to find solutions and guide residents to resources addressing poverty and the effects on our city. The Council Members on the committee are appointed annually by the Mayor. The committee does not have power or authority to commit the City or to take any binding action on behalf of the whole Council. Committee reports will be made at the Council's regular business meetings. The committee shall express their recommendations to the Council as a whole, proposing ordinances or resolutions for adoption by the Council. The committee will align its work with that of the City Council's strategic goals and priorities.

The committee will encourage interaction between residents, resources and local government. Many opportunities are available in our community, and with stronger social connections and communication we can provide education, support and friendship with basic resources that already exist to our residents. It is our primary motivation to provide this information, train and give opportunity for everyone to be successful. In order to make progress, sustainability needs to be seen as a priority for all economic and social aspects of society. Working as a team to accomplish these goals will build resiliency and create a happier, healthier Hemet.
