

## Hemet gets a taste of Hollywood

Idyllwild Film Festival holds awards ceremony in downtown Hemet

Hemet got a taste of Hollywood when the Idyllwild International Festival of Cinema chose to celebrate its awards ceremony at the historic Hemet Theatre on Sunday, March 10. Founded by independent filmmaker Stephen Savage, the festival, now in its 10th year, is slated to become Oscar accredited in time for its 2020 season.

Filmmakers from all over the world had gathered in Idyllwild to compete in the festival, which ran from March 5-10. The event has experienced exponential growth since its beginnings in 2010. It was this growth that prompted

the festival's executive director, Trinity Houston, herself a native of Hemet, to move the awards ceremony to the city.

"We had simply outgrown the Idyllwild area and needed a bigger venue for our awards ceremony," said Houston. "And it was truly amazing to watch the entire community of Hemet come together to help create an unforgettable experience."
