Transportation Permit shall be permitted per City of Hemet Code Section 66-166.
1. Applicant MUST USE attached City of Hemet TRUCK ROUTES whenever possible.
2. NO TRUCKS ALLOWED to turn RIGHT/LEFT on to SOUTH STATE STREET from FLORIDA AVE.
 In acceptance of this permit, the applicant certifies that he/she is in compliance with all applicable statutes and specifically section 65790(e) of the California Vehicle Code (CVC). OVERHEAD CLEARANCE - When height of load exceeds legal limit, it becomes the responsibility of the permittee to check all underpasses, over-crossings, bridges, overhead wires or other structures for impaired vehicle clearance and to arrange clearance or request alternative routing before commencing travel. Spotter required through traffic signals and for overhead utilities. The transporter is responsible for compliance with Financial Responsibility Law of the California Vehicle Code and is liable for any damage to city streets or for personal injury or property damage which may occur while acting under the authority of this permit.

HEMET, CA Code of Ordinance - CHAPTER 78 ARTICLE III

Sec. 78-61. - Designated routes for vehicles over 14,000 pounds in weight.

(a) Except as designated in this section, it shall be unlawful to operate any vehicle on streets within the city when the maximum gross weight of such vehicle exceeds 14,000 pounds, unless such vehicle is operated on such restricted streets for the purpose of making delivery or picking up a load, in which case such vehicle may be driven on such streets for not more than the minimum distance necessary for that purpose. (b) The following streets and highways are hereby designated as routes for vehicles exceeding 14,000 pounds. Vehicles subject to the provisions of Public Utilities Code §§ 1031—1036 are exempted from the provisions of this section. (1) Florida Avenue (SR 74). (2) San Jacinto Street (SR 79), between Florida Avenue on the south and the northerly city limits. (3) State Street. (4) Sanderson Avenue. (5) Stetson Avenue between Sanderson Avenue on the west and State Street on the east. (6) Domenigoni Parkway. (7) Warren Road. (8) Menlo Avenue between Sanderson Avenue on the west and San Jacinto Street on the east.

HEMET, CA CODE OF ORDINANCE - CHAPTER 66 ARTICLE VI

Sec. 66-152. - Obstructing inspections.

A person shall not obstruct the director of public works in making any inspection to determine compliance with the conditions of a permit issued under this article.

Sec. 66-154. - Display of permit.

A permittee under this article shall make the permit available for inspection by the director of public works or by any peace officer or other public officer or employee having responsibility for safety or maintenance of the city streets. Each permit for moving must be in or attached to the vehicle or combination of vehicles to which it refers. In cases where a building or structure is moved in more than one section at the same time, on each section on which the original permit is not attached there shall be affixed a true copy of the original permit.

Sec. 66-155. - Cancellation of permit.

The director of public works, for cause, may cancel a permit issued under this article unless the permitted activity is commenced within the time specified and is diligently prosecuted to completion.
