City of Hemet Announces Vacancy for District 1 City Council Seat

Applications Accepted Through May 6, 2025

Hemet, CA – April 28, 2025 – The City of Hemet announces a vacancy on the City Council following the resignation of Mayor Pro Tem Carole Kendrick, who will formally step down as the District One representative on May 9, 2025. In accordance with the City Charter, the City Council will appoint a qualified individual to serve the remainder of the term.

Application Process

Residents of District One interested in serving on the City Council are encouraged to apply. The position includes a monthly stipend of \$1,900. Applications are being accepted now through **Tuesday, May 6, 2025, at 5:30 p.m.** The City Council will review applications and consider appointments during the **May 8, 2025** council meeting.

Eligibility Requirements

Applicants must meet the following criteria:

- Be a registered voter residing within Hemet's District One
- Be a U.S. citizen
- Be at least 18 years of age
- Not be disqualified from holding public office under California law
