PLANNING COMMISSION: Must be at least 18 years old and a city resident within the City of Hemet or sphere of influence. Created in accordance with the provisions of the State Planning Act, the Commission consists of five members appointed by the City Council to serve four-year terms. The Commission meets on the first and third Tuesdays of the month at 6:00 p.m.

HEMET PUBLIC LIBRARY BOARD OF TRUSTEES: Must be at least 18 years old and have one year of residency within the City of Hemet or sphere of influence. The Library Board consists of five members appointed by the City Council for three-year terms. It meets on the 3rd Friday of each month at 10:00 a.m. Responsibilities are statutory and include setting policy on the operation and services of the Library. The Board advises the City Council on the Library's budgetary needs, services, and related matters.

MOBILE HOME RENT REVIEW COMMISSION: Must be at least 18 years old and a City resident within the City of Hemet or sphere of influence. Established by Ordinance No. 772, an initiative of the voters of the City of Hemet, this Commission meets by request only and with duties as outlined in the Hemet Municipal Code. It consists of five members appointed by the City Council to 3-year terms. The Commission shall be made up of one mobile home park owner, one mobile home park tenant, and three "at large" residents who do not live in mobile home parks.

MEASURE U CITIZEN OVERSIGHT COMMITTEE: In accordance with Hemet City Ordinance No. 1918, the Measure U Citizen Oversight Committee consists of 7 members appointed by the city council to serve two (2) year terms. The purpose of the committee is to independently review and advise upon the City's proposed expenditures of Measure U Funds, as well as the actual expenditures of Measure U Funds, and review the annual audit conducted of Measure U Funds, as required by the Ordinance. The Committee is advisory only and reports its comments directly to the City Council. Eligible community members must reside within the city limits or the sphere of influence or own a business having its primary offices located within the city limits. A majority (4 or more) of the committee members shall be residents of the City of Hemet.

HEMET YOUTH COUNCIL: The City established the Hemet Youth Council through Resolution 2025-072 to address youth underrepresentation. The Youth Council serves as a formal link between young people and the City Council, elevating youth voices, promoting civic engagement, and involving youth in community decision-making. The council consists of 19 members who advise on youth-related issues, support City initiatives, and report annually to the City Council. Members ages 13–19 are appointed by the City Council to a one-year term and must be enrolled in high school or equivalent within the City of Hemet, Hemet Sphere of Influence, or Hemet Unified School District (HUSD) boundary, maintain a minimum grade point average (GPA) of 2.5, and provide a letter of recommendation to be eligible.
