NOTICE OF PLANNED MOSQUITO TREATMENT IN SEATTLE BASIN

AUGUST 26, 2014, 6:00AM TO 8:00AM

In a recent news article, the Riverside County Department of Environmental Health reported that mosquitoes in the Hemet, Murrieta and Temecula areas tested positive for West Nile Virus (WNV). The County has notified the City of Hemet that on Tuesday, **August 26, 2014, County staff will be performing fogging of the City of Hemet Seattle Basin from 6:00am to 8:00am** to abate mosquitoes from the channel. The Seattle Basin located north of Seattle Street between West Menlo Avenue and North Cawston Avenue. This basin is regularly inspected and treated for mosquitos by the County.
