

Trash Carts Storage: Carts placed in a public right-of-way for collection shall be placed and removed from the right-of-way not to exceed 24 hours before and after the collection day.

When storing your carts, no carts shall be visible from the public right-of-way.

HMC Sec 62-11

1. Carts should be placed at the curbside no later than 6:00 am on the collection day and should be placed with handles and wheels facing towards your home.
2. Lids should be closed. Please do not overload.
3. Carts should be removed from the curbside of Bin or Carts will not be collected.
4. Items placed outside of Bins or Carts will not be collected.

Trash Cart Requirements



Bulky Items: Items that cannot fit in your automated carts are considered bulky items. Common bulky items include:

Couches - Mattresses - Desk - Chairs - Tables



Each residential customer is entitled to two bulky item pickups free of charge per calendar year. Service will include a combination of loose large items not to exceed the equivalent of three cubic yards or two individual large items such as a tv, couch or mattresses. **Please contact CR&R to schedule your pickup.**

Trash carts should be placed at curb side without blocking the public right-of-way. Carts should be placed three feet apart from each other.

- Do not place trees in plastic bags.
- Place tree in your green organics cart or beside your carts for collection.
- Trees 6 feet or taller must be cut in half.

Palm fronds are not recyclable. Please place cut palm fronds in the trash cart.
