Activities

--Easter Egg Shape Hunt: choose 5 shapes and cutout 3 of each shape. Put each of the shapes inside a plastic egg. Hide the shapes and let your preschooler find them. Have your child name the shapes (and colors) as they open the eggs.

--Eggs-ercises: make a list of 12 activities for your child to do such as 2 bunny hops, 4 giant frog leaps, 6 jumping jacks, 3 arm flaps, and put an activity in each of the eggs. Using an empty egg carton, put your eggs in your carton so that your preschooler has a carton of *eggs-ercises*. Then let your child pick an egg to open and then do that activity together. ←Carrot Counting: cut out carrot triangles and write a number on each carrot. Ask your child to glue the correct number of green strips to the tops of the carrots.

--B is for Bunny: draw a capital letter B on a piece of paper and let your child glue cotton balls along the letter. Add an extra cotton ball at the bottom for a tail and cotton balls on top for ears. Glue on googly eyes and a pompom nose inside the top part of the B for the bunny face.



--Easter Egg Maracas: Have your child put some dried beans in a plastic egg. Then turn the eggs into maracas by taping 2 spoons around the egg. Also tape the spoon stems together to make it easier to hold. Shake! ([dishfunctionaldesigns](http://dishfunctionaldesigns.com))
