A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HEMET, CALIFORNIA, CALLING AND GIVING NOTICE OF A GENERAL ELECTION TO BE HELD ON TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 8, 2022, FOR THE ELECTION OF THE OFFICE OF CITY COUNCIL MEMBER IN DISTRICT 2 AND DISTRICT 5; AND REQUESTING THE REGISTRAR OF VOTERS, COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE TO CONDUCT THE ELECTION

The City Council of the City of Hemet (hereafter referred to as the "City Council") does resolve as follows:

WHEREAS, pursuant to the requirements of the laws of the State of California relating to general law cities, the City Council of the City of Hemet, calls and orders to be held in the City of Hemet, California, on Tuesday, November 8, 2022, a consolidated general municipal election for the members of the City Council in District 2 and District 5, which shall end December 2026; and

WHEREAS, The City Council requests the Register of Voters, County of Riverside, to conduct the consolidated election.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HEMET DOES HEREBY FIND AND RESOLVE TO:

SECTION 1. That pursuant to the requirements of the laws of the State of California relating to general law cities within said state, there shall be, and there is hereby called and ordered held in the City of Hemet, California on Tuesday, November 8, 2022, a general municipal election of the qualified electors of said city for the purpose of electing members of the city council in District 2 and District 5, which shall end on December 2026. City Council Districts are defined in the Hemet Municipal Code Section 2-45 - Establishment of City Council Electoral Districts.

SECTION 2. That the ballots to be used at the election shall be in form and content as required by law.

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SECTION 3. That the polls for said election shall be open at seven o'clock a.m. on the day of the election, and shall remain open continuously from said time until eight o'clock p.m. of the same day when said polls shall be closed, pursuant to Elections Code §10242, except as provided in § 14401 of the Elections Code of the State of California.

SECTION 4. That in all particulars not recited in this Resolution, said election shall be held and conducted as provided by law for holding municipal elections in said city.

SECTION 5. That the City shall reimburse the County Registrar of voters for services performed when the work is completed and upon presentation to the City of a properly approved bill.

SECTION 6. That notice of the time and place of holding the election is given and the City Clerk is authorized, instructed and directed to give further or additional notice of the election, in time, form and manner as required by law.

SECTION 7. That the City Clerk is directed to forward without delay to the County Registrar of Voters a certified copy of this Resolution.

SECTION 8. That the City Clerk shall certify to the passage and adoption of this Resolution and enter it into the book of original Resolutions.


